

Join a Saco-S association — it's well worth it

Your work is a major part of your life. You spend the majority of your waking life at work, so it is essential that you are happy there and are able to do a good job. But someone needs to ensure that you have good working conditions and opportunities to grow and develop. That's what we do. Our mission is to create good working conditions for you and your fellow academics. Over 80 000 members know that we do our job well. And the more members we have, the greater our impact and the more we can improve your everyday life.

Collective agreements for your benefit

We negotiate with your employer about the terms and conditions of your job, and what we agree forms the collective agreement. This regulates how much your employer will contribute towards your pension, how much you will be paid when on parental leave or sick leave and how much holiday you are entitled to. It also sets the rules for how your salary is set, e.g. how your work is to be assessed and the process for the annual salary review. As a Saco-S member, the framework of the collective agreement enables you to make individual agreements regarding salary, pension contributions, working hours and

Is your situation about to change? Talk to us

When you want to change job, are about to become a parent or planning to sign an employment contract, all kinds of questions can pop up. That is a good time to contact your trade union. Our advice and service is adapted to your unique needs. Our officers are experts on issues such as holidays, pensions, redundancy, employment contracts, working hours, overtime, parental leave and leave of absence.

How is your salary compared with those of others? Contact us

We have Sweden's largest database of academics' salaries. When you get a new job or your salary is to be reviewed, search the database to see what salary level you should have. Our officers will help you develop your arguments ahead of your salary dialogue.

Perhaps the cheapest (and best) unemployment insurance

AEA, the Unemployment Insurance Fund for Graduates, has among the best benefits of all unemployment insurance funds, as unemployment among academics is relatively low. That keeps our insurance premiums low.

Which Saco-S union is best for you?

The unions within Saco-S base their membership on a profession or degree, and each has specialist expertise on the education and labour market of its members. So it doesn't matter if you change employer or sector, you can still be a member of your union if you move. And if you are a university teacher, a researcher or a PhD candidate, you can have dual membership.

What is Saco-S?

Saco-S is a negotiation organization for state-employed academics. We

pursue issues at central level in negotiation with Arbetsgivarverket, the Swedish Agency for Government Employers. We sign collective agreements on pensions, general employment conditions, holidays, sickness benefits, parental leave and more. A good example of what strong negotiating organization can achieve is Trygghetsavtalet, the employment security agreement for government employees. As well as financial compensation during unemployment, this agreement provides a range of other benefits.

Saco-S consists of 22 Saco unions. Together, we represent over 83 000 academics. Members of a Saco union in the state sector are covered by the negotiations conducted by Saco-S.
